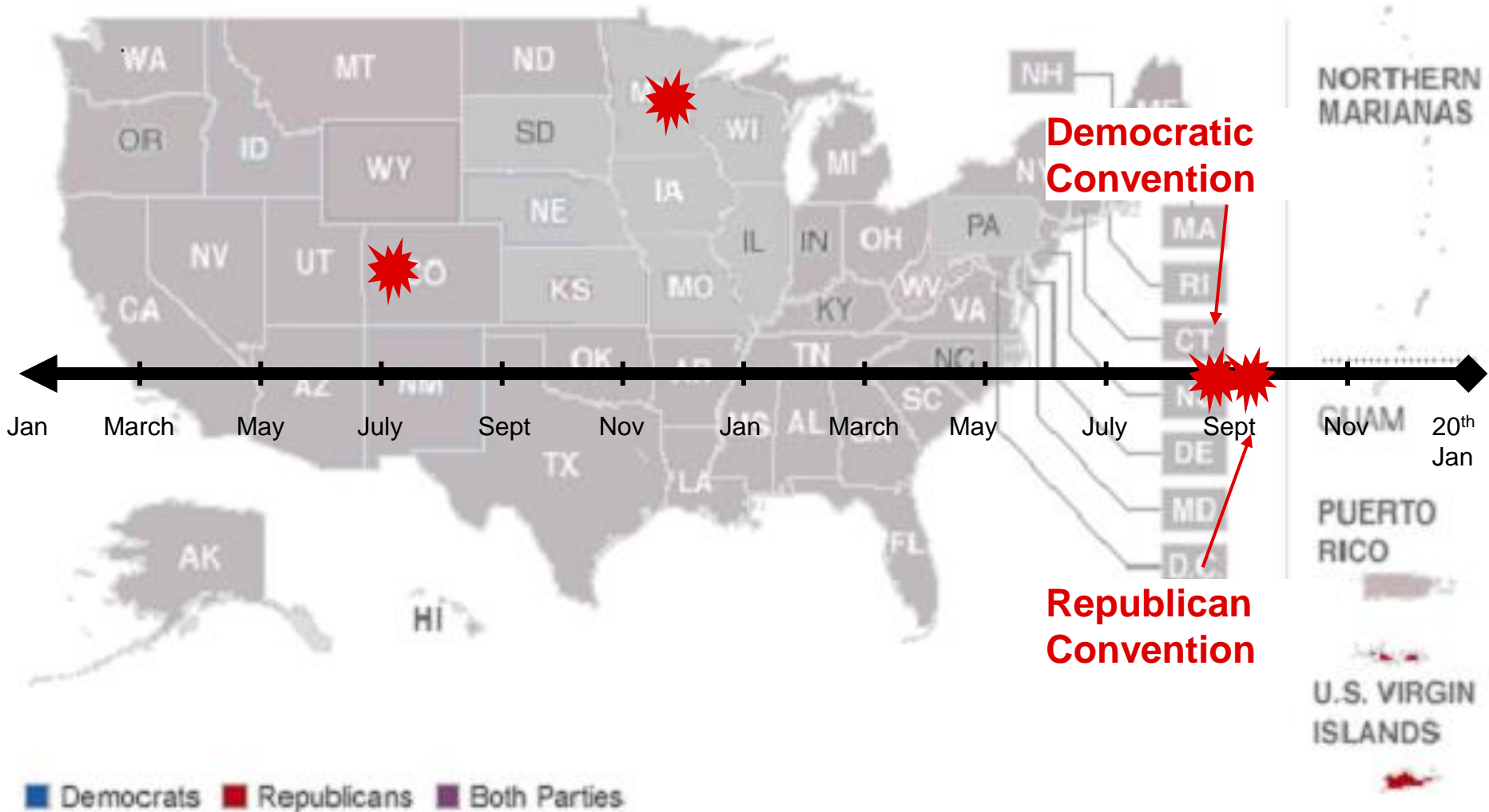
Claimed victory –
